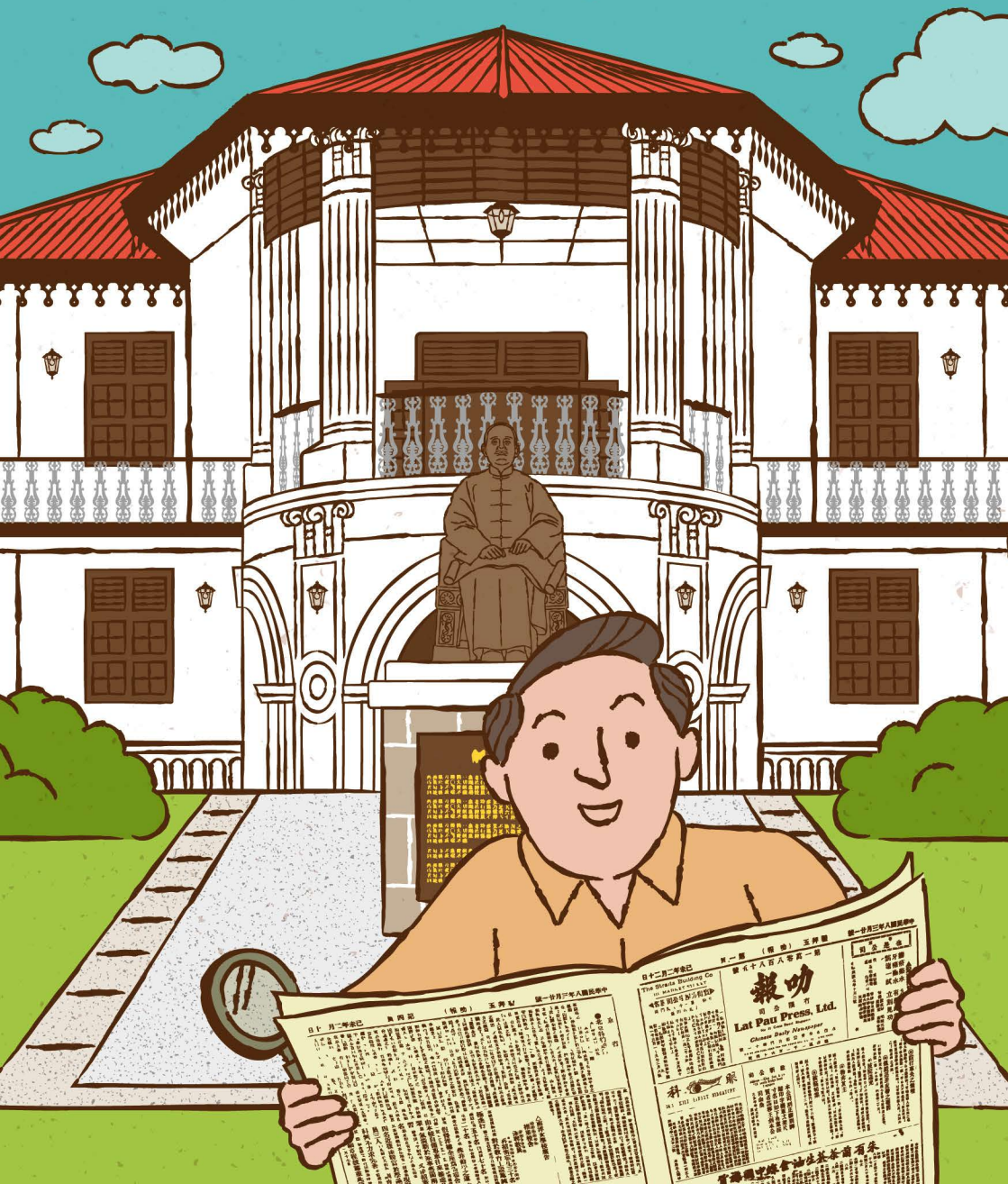

drinks outside



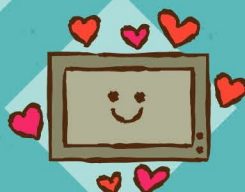

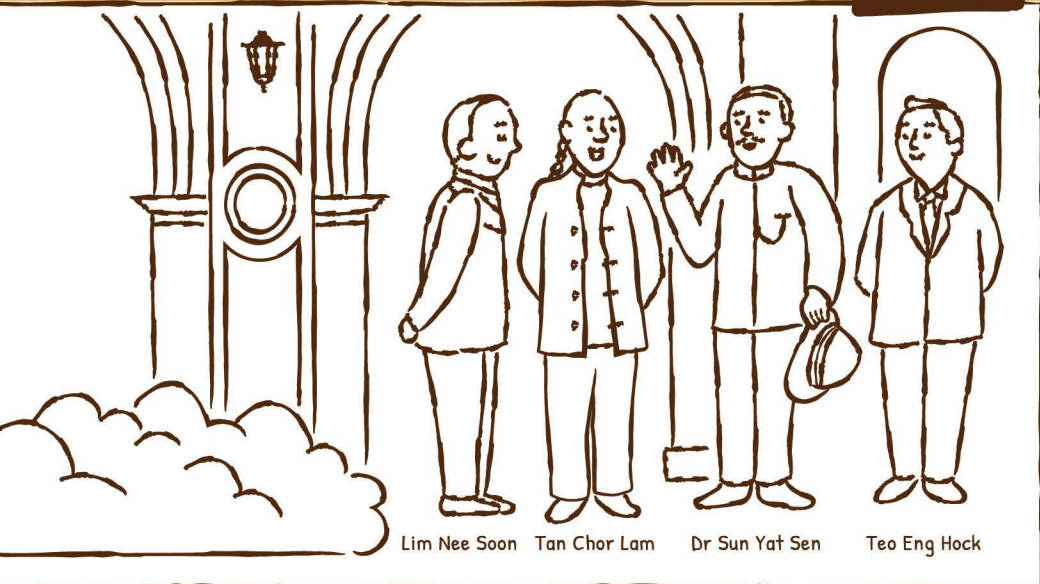

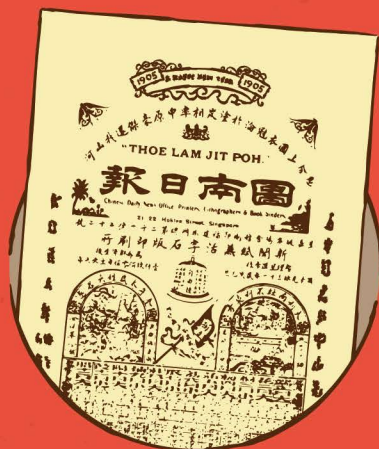
How about you? Share with me an example of how you express care and concern for your family members or friends.

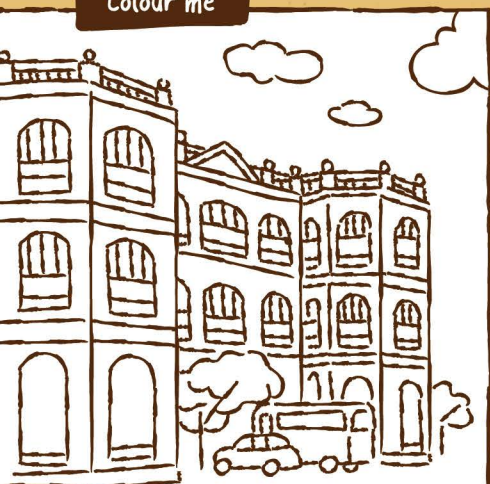
What other ways can we receive information from around the world today?
